2. Vintage Kitchen: Wolf double-gas oven; sub-zero refrigerator; two Miele dishwashers; Wolf 5-burner gas stove; Ann Saks tile; Nickel Waterworks fixtures; Custom Cabinets; Mahogany-topped island; Granite countertops
3. Butlers Pantry: Wet bar with Waterworks fixtures and sink; soapstone countertops; custom cabinets; Insta-hot water dispenser
4. Dining Room: Waterford Chandelier; Antique Parisien Sconces
5. Sitting Room: Custom Walnut Cabinets
6. Study: New marble around fireplace; custom walnut paneling and bookcases
7. Living Room: Built-in bookshelves with granite; new granite surround on fireplace; Original mantel carved by Italian craftsman; writing porch with natural stone floor
8. Powder Room: Waterworks fixtures; Ann Saks sconces
9. New energy efficient Pella windows and doors
10. New staircases to second floor from dining room and down to mud room and media room
11. New full bath with marble, stone flooring, custom glass shower and brass sink and fixtures.

13. Master bath addition with white marble floor and shower; custom glass shower; free standing tub and waterworks nickel sinks and faucets
